

### Message from the President:

It has been a long hot Summer, but at last Fall is here. With that comes not only cooler, nicer weather and less rain, but the best part is that our friends and neighbors are returning to Florida. We have missed them and want to say, "welcome home."

We have had some very expressive meetings, since May 21<sup>st</sup>, regarding the complex. The issues still are in desperate need of maintenance and repairs, the replacement funds still must be paid, this is the reality of where we are. We will be moving forward with another vote shortly with discussions by all to achieve our goals.

We will adjust in areas to bring the costs down and we can wait on some items so that the replacement funds will be able to pay for some of the items next year. But the one thing that most homeowners are stating is "fix it right no shortcuts. We do not want to have to do major repairs in a few years from now."

Everyone, states the same thing, "why was this not done in the past, why do we need to pay for it." There is no answer for that, there is no finger pointing. Your Rec Board knows one thing, we must all move forward as a community of one, to achieve our goals. Fix all we can with a special assessment, which you will vote on electronically or by mail.

This Rec Boards goal is to keep our monthly assessment fee low (right now we receive \$65.00 per month per home) we believe we will be able to maintain that if, we are not paying for constant emergency repairs.

The new accounting firm wants us to consider going to a management company. They do not feel any homeowners elected to the Rec Board should try to get all these repairs, maintenance, and replacement funds solved with the distention shown this past Spring and Summer. (yes, they watched all the meetings on our website) This would eventually cost us a great expense. The management company would tell us what we are doing, and how they want the repairs completed, once they are hired, they do not go away, they are here to stay. Yes, the board has a voice, but the pressure would be high to comply. Our promise to you as the Rec Board is we will not make that decision, without a long, intense discussion with the community, and as a community we decide. Yes, there are some homeowners who are stating "go to a management company," but they do not understand the ramifications of doing it as a Master Association not a Plat. We have 3 buildings, 1 pool area, tennis/bocce area, gym, daytime events, weekend events, and I can keep going, all this plus vendor management is part of the cost \$\$\$\$\$.

The Rec Board has worked diligently with our Plats and homeowners to get the electronic voting forms from each homeowner. We are happy to state that the gathering of 1126 forms is going extremely well. We will be sending out our agenda and zoom link through our own rec email starting October to all those that have filled out the form with their email information. This will be the last month that we will ask the Plats to send it out for us.

Through the website you will be able to access the zoom link for our Rec Board meetings which are the first Tuesday of the month, also any other essential information will be listed on the site. For any Special meetings regarding voting or special assessments, you will receive notification through snail mail, and it will also be on the website.

I know this is a long Presidents message, but there are key areas, you should be able to see, read, and review. Please do not hesitate to contact any Rec Board member with any questions. There also are many us of us at the Rec Center throughout the day. If you want to discuss anything we can talk with you in person or on the phone.

We all need to remember that we are in this together. The Rec Center is a part of every one of us whether we use the facilities or not.

I still believe what I said when I came on the board January 2024, "If we build it, they will come!" and we have more activities everyday happening every day. Mahjong is booming, Canasta is played, billiards now have daily players, along with the evening events, the pool is busy, Bocce has grown, Zumba class is the 2/3 Wednesday of each month, and Pool Zumba is every Wednesday night in Plat 2. Let us get our tennis and pickleball people back on the courts. The entertainment committee has many awesome events coming up.

We are 1126 strong, we are a phenomenal, wonderful, community which I am proud to live in along with all the other 1125 homes. Let us work together to preserve what we all love.


